Oral manifestations of systemic diseases

Secondary renal hyperparathyroidism (rubber jaw) appears radiographically as if teeth are floating in the jaw without surrounding bone.

Renal failure may cause ulcerations of the oral tissues or tongue.

Oral lesions associated with autoimmune diseases

Pemphigus vulgaris, bullous pemphigoid, systemic lupus erythematosus (SLE) are immune mediated skin diseases in which oral lesions are frequently found.
