

## Restorative Dentistry

### Composite restoration of enamel defects

Enamel defects in the crown of a tooth may be congenital or acquired. Dependent upon the depth of the defect, the defect may be smoothed to remove the rough edges and dead enamel and the underlying dentin 'sealed' with a bonding agent or the defect may be restored with a composite restoration.
