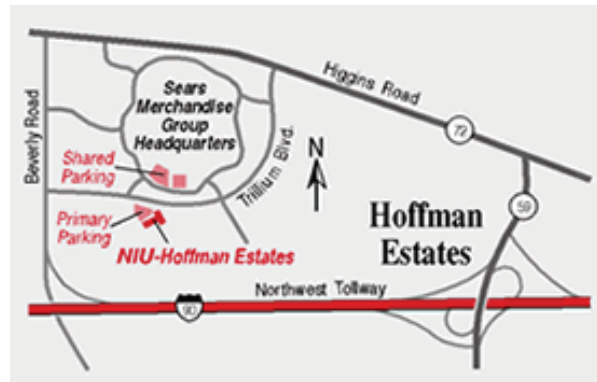
About the Speaker...

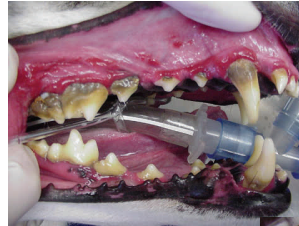
