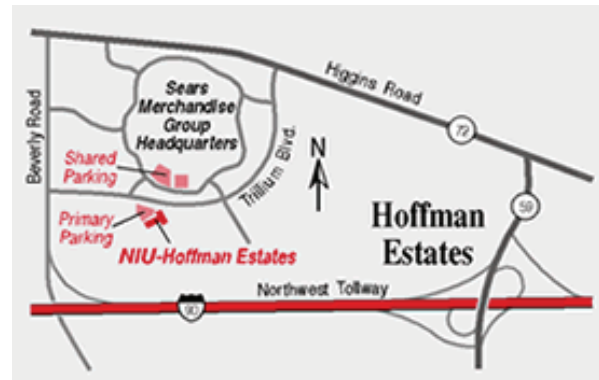


Dr. Charlier and Gracie

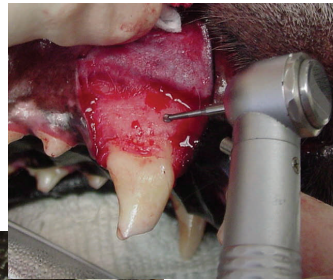
