

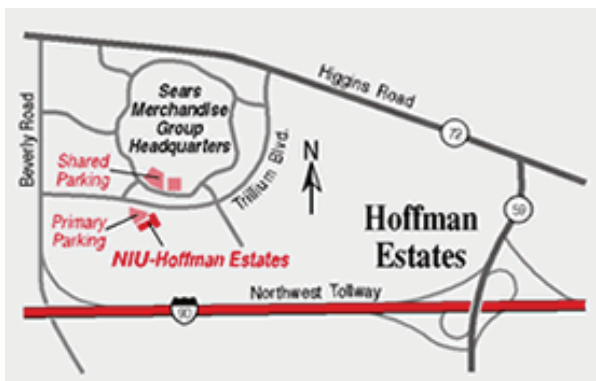
## About the Speaker...

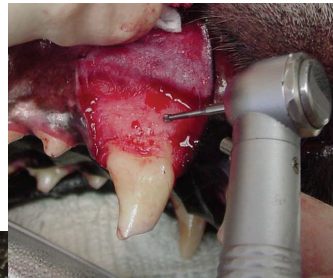
